Student Ambassador Program

Position Description

The LCCC Student Ambassadors are an elite group of students who represent Luzerne County Community College Foundation as the first point of contact in a number of initiatives designed to promote the College to the general community. Student Ambassadors are current students who are selected on the basis of leadership, scholarship, professionalism and desire to promote Luzerne County Community College through Foundation and Alumni events, art exhibits and other activities as hosts and hostesses of the college. The Ambassadors are selected though an interview process and, if selected, they will serve in an environment that utilizes their interpersonal communication skills and enthusiasm with a diverse population.

Student Ambassador Qualifications

Student Ambassadors must be enrolled in 6 or more credit hours per semester and stay enrolled throughout the term with a minimum of 2.5 G.P.A. Student Ambassadors must display professionalism, responsibility, dependability and punctuality.

Student Ambassador Responsibilities

Student Ambassadors must participate in the following events: openings, art exhibits, alumni activities, Foundation activities, Open Houses, scholarship dinner, etc. Attendance at a monthly meeting is required.

Student Ambassador Incentives

- Campus recognition
- Leadership training and certificate
- Resume experience and letters of recommendation
- Establish professional and personal contacts
- Unprecedented experience in public relations (meeting people, public speaking, representing the College) which develops skills and confidence vital to success in job placement and career advancement
- After completion of the required events, a scholarship will be applied to the ambassador's student account.

Other information

- There are up to eight positions available.
- Ambassadors are expected to work a *minimum* of 25 hours per semester.
- All responsibilities are required in order to receive the scholarship.
- Ambassadors are responsible for notifying Kristen Corcoran, kcorcoran@luzerne.edu or Teddi
 Janosov tjanosov@luzerne.edu if they are unable to make a scheduled event with at least 24
 hours' notice.
- Unexcused absences will result in termination for the Student Ambassador program.

Selection Criteria

- Enrolled in 6 or more credits; G.P.A. minimum 2.5
- Sincere desire to represent Luzerne County Community College
- Enthusiasm
- Effective Speaking Ability
- Ability to adapt to a variety of situations
- Ability to work well with others
- Responsibility and dependability
- Demonstrated skills in interpersonal communications and ability to effectively relate with people of diverse cultural, social and educational backgrounds.

Selection Process

Applications are due Tuesday, November 23, 2021. Interviews will be held during early December 2021 and new Student Ambassadors will be notified shortly after.

Student Ambassador Contract

If selected, I agree to meet the following expectations during my semester as an Ambassador:

- 1. Participate in all required Student Ambassador Activities per semester.
- 2. Attend all scheduled monthly meetings.

If selected to represent Luzerne County Community College as a Student Ambassador, I will receive:

- 1. Scholarship
- 2. Polo shirt with embroidered LCCC logo
- 3. Name Badge

I understand that I will be excluded from further participation in the Ambassador program if any of the following occur:

- 1. Become enrolled for less than 6 credits.
- 2. Loss of good standing within the college or community
- 3. G.P.A. drops below 2.5
- 4. Failure to fulfill the standard of the program (including class and meeting attendance, behavioral expectations and minimum participation).
